1.4. Share logins



2.1. Class options



Each chapter can be read **online, offline or on paper**.

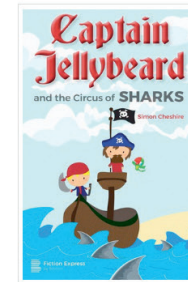
3.1. Reading levels

All users have access to all **three levels**. Therefore, using Fiction Express, teachers can manage different reading levels in the same class and students can read additional books for pleasure, including the *Library books* which have been previously created with the Fiction Express methodology.

Level 1 now includes an **entry level version** —Level 1 Lite—, with a reduced word count and simplified text, so that students who find Level 1 too challenging can also enjoy the story.

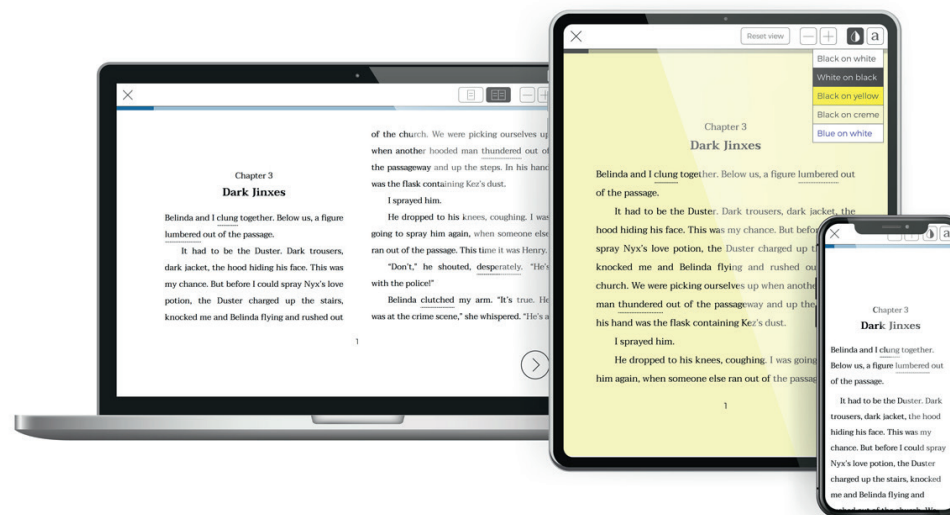




6. Book forum

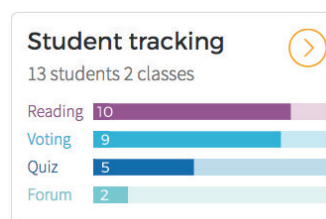

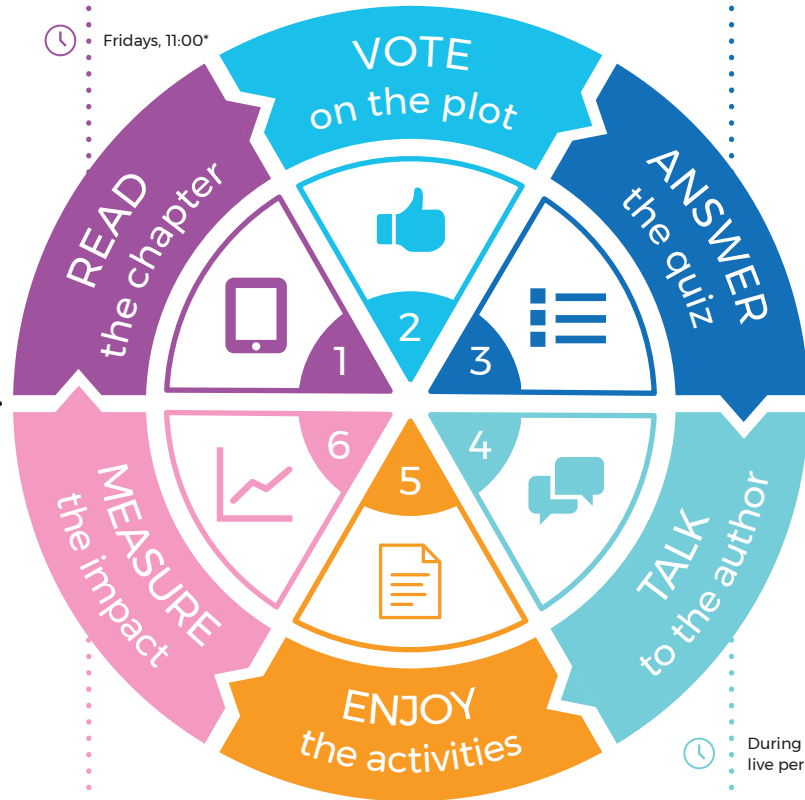
